### **Summer 2025 General Update**

The Visitors Center began operations on April 19<sup>th</sup>, creating a combined usable City workspace, gift shop and display areas. Specific Visitors Center branding was created for consistency in communication and marketing, including the creation of a VC logo. Inventory acquired from Destination Hudson was categorized into Square.

The Visitors Center employs one part-time staff member (Jennifer Cook) and three seasonal part-time store clerks and is open Tuesday- Friday afternoons and Saturday mornings. The VC follows the City Hall calendar for holiday closures but reserves the option to be open to assist with City and holiday events.
