A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDING FROM THE HUDSON KIWANIS ON BEHALF OF HUDSON PARKS.

WHEREAS, when the splash pad at Veterans Way Park was constructed, the Hudson Kiwanis donated \$75,000.00; and

WHEREAS, in the spring of 2025, the Hudson Kiwanis donated additional funds for the installation of a new shade sail, demonstrating Kiwanis' continued effort to improve upon and enhance the splash pad for all to enjoy; and

WHEREAS, the Hudson Kiwanis has now offered an additional \$8,942.14 grant towards the installation of a water feature at the splash pad; and

WHEREAS, this new water feature will improve the splash pad and the quality of the community's experience at Veterans Way Park and is, therefore, in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, as follows:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager and his designee are authorized to accept a \$8,942.14 grant from the Hudson Kiwanis for a new water feature at the splash pad at Veterans Way Park.
- <u>Section 2</u>. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.
- Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- <u>Section 4</u>. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
