A RESOLUTION ADOPTING IN CONCEPT THE 2026-2030 WALK AND BIKE HUDSON PLAN.

WHEREAS, City Council adopted a Connectivity Plan pursuant to Resolution No. 14-12, on February 19, 2014 and Resolution No. 18-158 on December 4, 2018; and adopted the Sidewalk and Trails Master Plan 2021-2015 on February 16, 2021 pursuant to Resolution No. 21-8; and

WHEREAS, the name of the 2021 master plan shall be changed from the Sidewalk and Trails Master Plan to the Walk and Bike Hudson Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City administration has proposed changes to the Plan as submitted; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to adopt in concept the updated Walk and Bike Hudson Plan for 2026-2030.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

- Section 1. The attached 2026-2030 Walk and Bike Hudson Plan is adopted by this Council and, furthermore, that it be understood that formal implementation of any of the projects or positions identified in this plan requires specific annual appropriation approval as provided in the City's Annual Appropriation Ordinance (Annual Budget) or any supplemental appropriation occurring throughout the year.
- Section 2. City Council agrees with the underlying process in which the priorities in the Plan were established.
 - Section 3. The Walk and Bike Hudson Plan is to be updated periodically.
- <u>Section 4</u>. City Council and staff will focus, though not necessarily limit, their attention on the highest ranked segments and priority efforts as shown in the Plan.
- <u>Section 5</u>. City staff will implement educational and safety improvements to enhance the City's non-vehicular travel network, as described in the Plan.
- Section 6. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
